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ABOUT THIS MANUAL

This manual briefly describes the basic processes and functions in Ramco Aviation Solution.

WHO SHOULD READ THIS MANUAL

This manual is intended for users who are managing the Aviation industry processes and are new to Ramco Aviation Solution. This manual assumes that the user is familiar with the Aviation Industry nomenclatures and systems based software.

HOW TO USE THIS MANUAL

Ramco Aviation Solution provides extensive Online Help that contains detailed instructions on how to use the application. Users are suggested to use this manual for specific references, along with the Online Help. This manual contains enough information to help the users perform the basic tasks and points toward the Online Help for more detailed information.

HOW THIS MANUAL IS ORGANIZED

The User Guide is divided into 2 chapters and index. Given below is a brief run-through of what each chapter consists of.

Chapter 1 provides an overview of the entire **Trade Compliance** process. The sub process is explained in the next chapter.

Chapter 2 focuses on the Trade Compliance Hub sub process.

The **Index** offers a quick reference to selected words used in the manual.

DOCUMENT CONVENTIONS

- The data entry has been explained taking into account the "Create" business activity. Specific references (if any) to any other business activity such as "Modify" and "View" are given as "Note" at the appropriate places.
- Boldface is used to denote commands and user interface labels.

Example: Enter Company Code and click the Get Details pushbutton.

Italics used for references.

Example: See Figure 1.1.

The ^{>>} icon is used for Notes, to convey additional information.

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1.INTRODUCTION

The **Trade Compliance Hub** retrieves and displays the Export Held Orders for the Parts. Documents having variation in 'Export From Country' and 'Export To Country' falls under the Trade Restriction. Orders which need Export Authorization, Export Licenses and Trade Compliance Data related to the Part will be displayed in the Trade Compliance Hub. Shipping of the parts will be generated/Confirmed once the license and authorization details are updated and then followed by the Commercial Invoice.

2.TRADE COMPLIANCE HUB

2.1 MANAGING SCREEN DEFAULTS AND PREFERENCES

This activity allows the user to view the Export Held Orders for the Parts. Orders which need Export Authorization, Export Licenses and Trade Compliance Data related to the Part will be displayed in the Trade Compliance Hub.

1. Select the icon (in the Trade Compliance Hub screen. The Manage Screen Defaults & Preferences page appears. See Figure 2.1.

- 2. In the **Set preference for** drop-down list box, select the user to set the Preference for a given User Role User Interface combination.
- 3. The system displays the list of parameters and corresponding **Permitted Values** in the **Defaults & User Preference** multiline.
- 4. Specify the Value and click Save to set the preference for the Trade Compliance Hub.

2.2 WORKING WITH TRADE COMPLIANCE HUB

The **Trade Compliance Hub** provides a dashboard to manage the documents having variation in 'Export From Country' and 'Export To Country', which would enlist the activities Pending Export Authorization, Pending Export License and Pending Trade Compliance Data.

1. Select the **Trade Compliance Hub** under the **Trade Compliance Management** business component in **Stock Management** business process. The **Trade Compliance Hub** page appears. *See Figure 2.2.*

- 2. Click the iii icon to view the On Hold order documents under tiles and retrieve the corresponding part details in the multiline.
- 3. The system displays the following tiles based on the details updated against the part along with the count of the order documents.
 - ▶ Pend. Exp. Auth Displays the count of On Orders that are held due to non-availability of Export Authorization.
 - Pend. Exp. License Displays the count of On Hold Orders due to non-availability of Export License.
 - Pend. Trd. Comp. Data Displays the count of On Hold Orders, if the Parts mentioned in the Orders does not have Trade Compliance details in the "Maintain Trade Compliance Information".
- 4. Click the **Q** icon to retrieve the Trade Compliance details of the parts in the multiline based on the entered search criteria.
- 5. Select the **Held Orders** checkbox to retrieve the Parts which are restricted with the Restriction Codes "Stock Restriction Code" as defined in the "Manage Part and Trade Restrictions" screen.
- 6. Click the **Search** pushbutton to retrieve the trade compliance details based on the entered criteria.

In the multiline,

- 7. The system displays the **Ref. Doc. #** and **Ref. Doc. Type** which is held.
- 8. The **Export Authorization #** which is already generated for the Part **#** Doc. Line **#** Combination and **Export Auth. Status** are displayed.
- 9. The system displays the **Part #** and **Part Description** of the On Hold document.
- 10. **ITAR Restriction?** indicates whether the part is ITAR restricted or not. The system displays the "Check Mark" if ITAR Restriction for the part is 'Yes' and " Cross Mark" if ITAR Restriction for the part is 'No' in "Maintain Trade Compliance Information" screen.
- 11. The system displays the Line #, Doc. Qty and Doc. UOM of the reference document.

- 12. Click the hyperlinked **External License #** for the Part to view the details of the Export licenses details for the Part # and also the quantity details which are authorized and the balance quantities.
- 13. The system displays the Export From Country and Export To Country.
- 14. The system displays the **Authorize Qty** and **Balance Qty** that can be exported against the Defined External License.
- 15. The ending date in the range of dates upto which the Export Authorization is valid is displayed in the **Valid To** field.
- 16. The Ship To Address ID and Ship To Address of the part to be exported.
- 17. **Shipping Note Exists** field indicates whether the shipping Note exists for the Held Orders which could be 'Yes' or 'No'.
- 18. The **Comp. Code Type** and **Comp. Ref #** defined for the part **#** in "Maintain Trade Compliance Information" screen of the "Part Administration" business component is displayed.
- 19. The system displays the **Last Pur. Cost**, **Last Sale Cost** and **Last Rep. Cost** of the part in the Reference Document for which the Trade compliance information is defined.
- 20. The **Trading Partner #** and **Trading Partner Name** of the part in reference document are displayed.
- 21. The system displays the **Restriction Code** of the part in reference document defined in the **Set Inventory Process Parameters** screen and the **Restriction Remarks** of the part.
- 22. Use the **Chat** icon to navigate to the collaborate screen.
- 23. Click the Gen. Export Auth. Pushbutton to generate the export Authorization.

To proceed further,

- 24. Use the Quick Links drop-down list box to navigate to the required screen. The system lists the following screens:
 - Maintain Trade Compliance Information
 - Maintain External License
 - Maintain Part and Trade Restrictions
 - Record Shipping Note
 - View Shipping Note

Advanced Search Pop-up

The Advanced Search Pop-up enables the user to perform advanced search to retrieve the desired results in the multiline.

1. Select the Advanced Search link in the 'Search section' of the Trade Compliance Hub screen. The Advanced Search pop-up appears. *See Figure 2.3.*

- 2. Enter the Export Auth. # and specify the Export Auth. Status of the Export Authorization.
- 3. Select the License Status, Legal Regulation and License Type drop-down list box.
- 4. Enter the Valid From and Valid To date in the range of dates from which the Export Authorization is valid.
- 5. Enter the Part #, Strip Part #, Part Description, Part Type, Part Category, Part Group, Mfr. Part #, Mfr. # and Mfr. Country of the part.
- 6. Specify the **Comp. Code Type** and the **ITAR Restriction?** to indicate whether the part is ITAR Restricted or not.
- 7. Select the **Held Orders** checkbox to retrieve the Parts which are restricted with the Restriction Codes "Stock Restriction code" as defined in the "Manage Part and Trade Restrictions" screen.
- 8. Click the **Search** pushbutton to retrieve the results based on the specified search criteria.

2.2.1 EXPORT AUTHORIZATION DETAILS POP-UP

This Pop-up facilitates generation of Export Authorization # and to record its details.

1. Select the **Gen. Export Auth.** pushbutton in the 'Pend. Exp. Auth.' Tab of the **Trade Compliance Hub** screen. The **Export Authorization Details** pop-up appears. *See Figure 2.4.*

- 2. Enter the Export Auth. #.
- 3. Select the **Numbering Type** and **Export Auth. Status** of the Export Authorization.
- 4. Enter the **External License #** of the part and the **Valid From**, **Valid To** date in the range of dates from which the Export Authorization is valid.
- 5. The system displays the **Balance Qty** and **Balance Value** of parts which can be exported against the Defined External License.
- 6. Click the **Save** pushbutton to record the Export Authorization details.

2.2.2 TRADE COMPLIANCE REFERENCE POP-UP

This Pop-up enables the user to view the license details of the part # which is used in the Order Transactions. Trade Compliance Reference Details including Part Classification details, External License, Authorization can be viewed from Orders. If the License is Not Available for the Qty. ordered or is Expired or the Part Classification data is not available, Order will be Held, using the Restriction framework. Those details can be viewed from this screen.

1. Select the **Gen. Export Auth.** pushbutton in the 'Pend. Exp. Auth.' Tab of the **Trade Compliance Hub** screen. The **Export Authorization Details** pop-up appears. *See Figure 2.5.*

- 2. In the header section, the system displays the Document Type, Document #, Status of the document.
- 3. The system displays the **Trade Comp. Status** of the Order **#** which could be one of the following:
 - Held If Trade Compliance based restriction is applied on any of the Parts in the document.
 - Released If Trade Compliance based restriction is not available to any Part in the document.
- 4. The **Part #** and **Part Description** are displayed.
- 5. The **Comp. Code Type** and **Comp. Ref. #** of the part in Held Order are displayed
- 6. Export Ref. Code-1 and Export Ref. Code-2 used to classify the part for export are displayed.
- 7. The system displays the Export License #, Export Auth. # and Valid Till date for the Export Authorization #.
- 8. **Export To country** displays the country mentioned in the "Ship To Address ID" field for the Part # in the Reference Document #.
- 9. **Trade Comp. Restriction** indicates whether the Trade Compliance Restriction is available for the Part *#*, Export from Country, Export to Country or customer which could be "Yes" or "No".
- 10. **Restriction Code** is the code defined in the "Manage Part Restriction" Screen for the Part # and Reference Document # combination.

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
